Single Center Of Interest

Fill the Frame

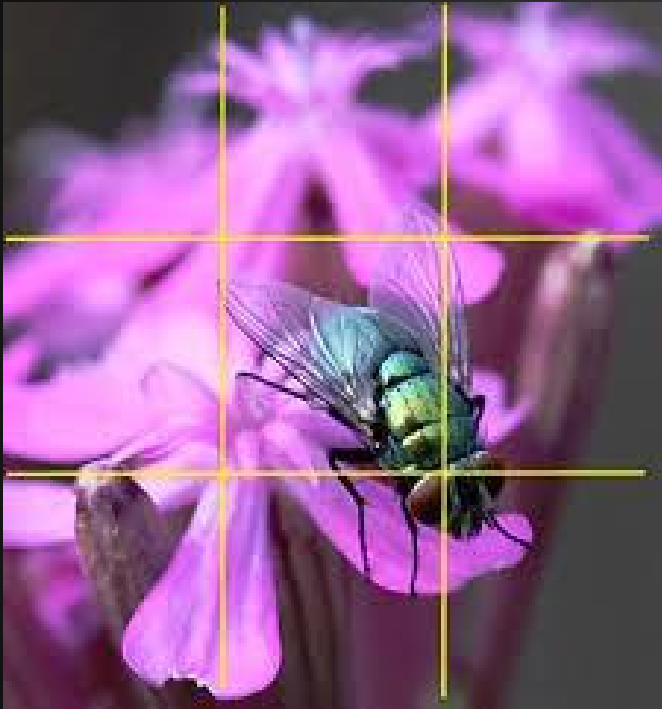


The rocks fill the entire frame instead of it just being a single rock.

Rule of thirds



Leading Subject
